#### PROPERTY HISTORY & USE

This property was owned by one of the original landowners of this area. The family carefully selected this beautiful piece of property for their daughter, and the father built the house himself in the 1920s.

The creek is prolific, and the land is vast with a natural aquifer high up in the back of the property that could be used to make a large pond and could even be turned into a whole neighborhood or groups of cabins with the right owner. There are also beautiful natural elements such as giant ferns that flank the house on either side, azaleas on the side of the house, a fantastic lilac tree that blooms in the spring, apple trees throughout that are edible as well as lilies daffodils, poppies and peonies that all just grow on and around the property.
